Closing Date for Entries is Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

- **What time do I have to be ready?** 7:00pm
- **What should I bring?** Costume, Towel, Hat (if you want), Goggles, poolside towel, a drink
- **How long will I be on poolside and what happens?** The racing starts at 7:30pm and you can leave once you have finished your races or stay and watch the others. A coach or team manager will tell you where to go and when to report to officials for your race.
- **Can Family and Friends watch me?** Yes, from the balcony for a small charge.
- **How much will it cost?** The entry fee is £3.50 per event and spectator fee will be £2.50.

# **Terms and Conditions**

## 1. Introduction

1.1. Worsley Amateur Swimming Club (hereinafter 'the Club') Club Championship Meet (hereinafter 'the Meet') will be held in accordance with the relevant FINA/ASA/IPC Technical & Judicial Rules/Laws.

1.2. Bona Fide Coaches and Team Managers requiring access to the poolside must have permission issued by the Club. It is mandatory that all Coaches comply with the relevant ASA Child Protection Procedures and have an up to date DBS certificate.

1.3. Any question or dispute arising from these conditions or disputes related to a matter not covered in these conditions shall be determined by the Meet Director.

1.4. This Meet is open to all members of Worsley ASC Club affiliated to ASA/SASA or WASA. A swimmer shall be considered as foreign if they are not a member of a club affiliated to ASA/SASA or WASA.

## 2. The Meet

2.1. The closing date for entries will be determined in the release of the Entry Pack.

2.2. Age for the competition will be as of 31st December 2019.

2.3. Age Groups for the meet will be 7 and under, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14-15, 16 and over

## 3. Competition format.

3.1. There will be no separate events for swimmers with disabilities. All swimmers will be seeded in the heats according to their entry times.

## 4. The Events

4.1. 25m all strokes open to 7 and under, 8 years

50m all strokes open to 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 years

100IM open to 11 years and under

Open events will be 100m all strokes except the IM, plus the 200m Free and 200IM

4.2. All heats will be swum combined and will be heat declared winner.

## 5. Awards

5.1. Awards will be made to the Top 6 in the 25m events for the 7 years and under, 8, and 9 years categories, Top 3 in the 10, 11, 12, 13, 14/15, 16 and-over categories targeted for the top girl/boy awards (see section 5.2). If you are swimming in an open event that is not targeted for your age group for top girl/boy award then you will only be awarded a medal if you are in the top three regardless of age. (For example a 12 year old swimming in the 200m free who comes 4<sup>th</sup> overall but is the fastest 12 year old in the event will not receive a medal or extra points as the targeted events for a 12 year old are 50m all strokes and 200IM and this race is in addition to those / a 12 year old who comes 3<sup>rd</sup>, will receive a bronze medal but no additional points towards top girl / boy award)

5.2 There will be a top girl / boy in each age group category. Points will be allocated to the following manner 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 8 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 6 points for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4 points for 4<sup>th</sup>, 2 points for 5<sup>th</sup> places in the following events

7 and under / 8 years -25m Free, 25m Back, 25m Breast, 25m Fly.

9, 10, 11 years 50m Free, 50 Back, 50 Breast, 50 Fly plus 100IM

12, 13 years 50m Free, 50m Back, 50 Breast, 50 Fly plus 200 IM

14/15 and 16 and over 100m Free, 100 Back, 100 Breast, 100 Fly plus 200IM

## 6. Submission of entries

6.1. Entry fees for each event shall be £3.50

6.2. Cheques should be made payable to: Worsley ASC

6.3. There are no qualifying times for this competition. All entries will be accepted.

6.4. Entrants must be a Category 1 or 2 member of the Worsley ASC.

6.5. Entry times must be based on short course times (achieved in a 25m pool, long conversions will be accepted using pullbuoy conversion found at [www.pullbuoy.co.uk/times](http://www.pullbuoy.co.uk/times)).

6.6. The Meet Director reserves the right to restrict entries in the interests of safety, time constraints and to ensure the smooth running of the competition. Where this rule is invoked the Director will reduce the qualifying times for each event by the same percentage until the projected sessions lengths fall within licensed meet guidelines, rejecting swimmers who are outside these revised consideration times. Any entry rejected under these circumstances will be refunded.

6.7. Submitted entry times shall be used for seeding purposes as required.

6.8. Refunds will only be given where a competitor whose entry has been accepted, has to withdraw on medical grounds subject to an appropriate medical certificate being received by the Meet Director

6.9. Once an entry has been submitted improved times will not be accepted.

## 7. Confirmation of entry

7.1. Accepted swimmers details will be posted onto the website as soon as possible after the closing date for the competition. These should be used to cross check the accuracy of swimmer entries and to allow any necessary corrections to be made.

## 8. Meet procedures

8.1. Competitors or their representatives must inform the organisers of their intention to withdraw at least 45 minutes before the start of the session if they do not intend to swim. Withdrawal messages must state NAME, and THE EVENT(s).

8.2. Any swimmer who has previously withdrawn can be reinstated before the appropriate closing deadline without penalty.

8.3. There will be no refund of entry fees for such withdrawals unless the withdrawal is for medical reasons in which case an appropriate medical certificate must be provided
